The Commission services with the help of independent experts have recently evaluated the proposals submitted in the context of the above-mentioned call. Your proposal was evaluated against the criteria published for the call. The attached evaluation summary report (ESR) records the views of the expert evaluators and the scores that your proposal achieved.

Based on this evaluation by independent experts, the Commission services will rank in priority order those proposals that passed all the evaluation thresholds, and will then take a decision on the lists of proposals for which negotiations of the grant agreement can proceed. This letter does not prejudice the outcome of this process.

It is a very well prepared SA proposal related to nanoelectromagnetism (NEM). The background of the research field is reasonably presented. The objectives are properly defined and justified by the work package description.

Note: when a proposal only partially addresses the topics, this condition will be reflected in the scoring of this criterion.
 - Soundness of concept, and quality of objectives
 - Quality and effectiveness of the support action mechanisms, and associated work plan

2. Quality and efficiency of the implementation and the management (1) (Threshold 3.00/5)

Mark : 4.00
 Weight : 1.00

The management structure and procedures are clearly presented. Decision making procedure is appropriate. The quality of the consortium is good. Key persons have international experience being involved in several Collaborative projects or Networks. The role of each partner in the consortium is presented in detail. The complementarity of the partners is good. Appropriateness of the allocation and justification of the resources to be committed is well demonstrated.

*Certain improvements are still possible:
 Quality assessment procedure has been not considered.
 The total budget breakdown on WPs should have been included.
 The relation between project's funds and the foreseen additional research grants has not been explained in sufficient detail.*

- Appropriateness of the management structure and procedures
 - Quality and relevant experience of the individual participants
 - Quality of the consortium as a whole (including complementarity, balance) [only if relevant]
 - Appropriateness of the allocation and justification of the resources to be committed (staff, equipment ...)

3. Potential impact through the development, dissemination and use of project results (Threshold 3.00/5)

 Weight : 1.00

The contribution of the project to the expected impacts listed in the Work Programme is concise and informative. The proposed project could contribute to capacity building in Belarus, to implement a novel interdisciplinary science - NEM and to enhance participation of the Belarus in FP7. Networking with other research centres is well addressed. The project will contribute to increase job opportunities for young scientists. The management of IPR is properly planned. Socio-economic aspects should have been presented more in detail. Dissemination is addressed too vaguely.

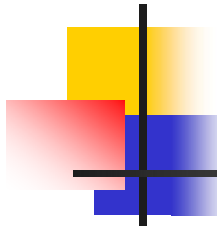

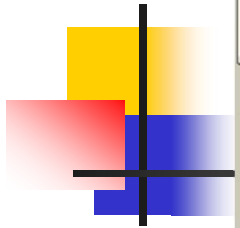

Dear Prof. Sergey Maksimenko,

As you were already informed the proposal entitled: "Institutional Development of Applied Nanoelectromagnetics:Belarus in ERA Widening" has been favourably evaluated by the Commission services with the help of independent experts.

You have already received a copy of the Evaluation Summary Report (ESR) on your proposal. The ESR reflects the comments of the independent experts and their advice to the Commission on the proposal. It does not necessarily reflect the views of the Commission or its services.

The Negotiation Mandate, which is the Commission’s assessment of the issues to be addressed when negotiating the grant agreement, is included in Annex I to this letter.

Following the evaluation, and on the basis of the Negotiation Mandate, it is estimated that the maximum Community financial contribution could be up to 380814 Euro for a period of up to 36 months. Accordingly, the Commission services wish to proceed to negotiations for a Grant Agreement on your proposal.

The Grant Agreement Preparation Forms (GPFs) are standard forms that collect the information that the Commission needs in order to prepare the grant agreement and provide programme-wide statistical information. GPFs prefilled with the information already in our files, and including information from your proposal, will be made available in a Web based electronic tool called NEF.
